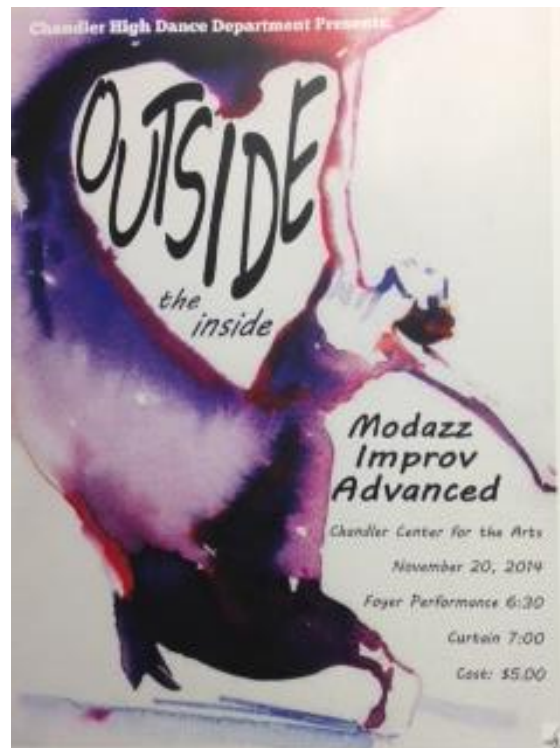

CHANDLER PUBLIC LIBRARY DATABASE- BIOGRAPHY REFERENCE CENTER

Have a student doing a biography report? Or are you just looking to learn about notable people, past and present? Find biographical information through the library's website by using *Biography Reference Center*. All the articles are reprinted from reference books, magazines and newspapers, and other print sources - a wider range of resources than you can find in a Google search!

To access *Biography Reference Center*, start at chandlerlibrary.org and hover your mouse over the purple RESEARCH tab. Then click Databases A-Z, and scroll down to choose *Biography Reference Center*. You'll need your library card and PIN if you're signing in from home.

The easiest way to search is to type in a person's name, but you can also use the Advanced Search to find people by time period, occupation, ethnicity, and more. Articles will indicate what print publication they originally appeared in. Look for the "Cite This Article" icon at the top of the article to find out how to list it on a bibliography or works cited page.

Seniors, are you applying to colleges that use the Common Application? There are 549 institutions, including the most selective ones, which utilize the Common App. For your counselor and teachers to complete the online recommendation on your behalf, you must first invite them on your Common Application. Only when your counselor and teachers receive the invitation through the Common App, can they access the system to complete the recommendation. If you have any questions regarding the Common App process, please see your counselor.

TAX CREDIT

Arizona law ARS 43-1089.01 enables taxpayers a tax credit contribution of up to \$400.00 per calendar year if filing status is Married, filing Joint Return; \$200.00 per calendar year if filing status is Single or Head of Household; and, \$200.00 per calendar year if filing status is Married filing separate return — for contributions that fund extracurricular activities in public schools.

Contributions eligible for a tax credit are donated directly to schools, not to the state or the school district. To participate you can print a form to complete and submit your contribution.
