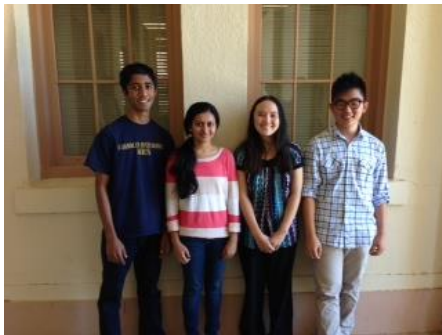




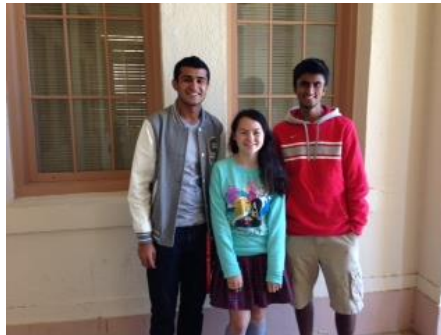
## CHS STUDENTS RECEIVE ACADEMIC RECOGNITION
