CHS FREEDOM CIRCLE

CHS is proud to announce the summer 2014 construction of the Chandler High School Freedom Circle. Construction of the Freedom Circle, including a new electronic marquee and garden, will begin in early June.

The Chandler High School Freedom Circle was funded by a generous donation from Gary and Christine Jones. Lt Col Gary Jones (USAF, Ret) started the Air Force Jr ROTC Detachment at Chandler High School. Known to the Chandler community simply as "the Colonel," Lt Col Jones launched AFJROTC Unit 2002-01 with four students in 2002, and eventually grew the unit into the largest in the East Valley, and one of the most highly honored in the Nation.

Twice each day, the Colonel's cadets march from North Campus to Old Main to raise and lower the flag in a formal ceremony. Because the school's flag poles sit in a place of honor in front of the school, the enhancement of the area around the flag poles provides a way to involve Chandler students, and the broader community, in the flag raising and lowering ceremonies, while honoring America in a prominent way.

The Colonel is a Vietnam Veteran, a graduate of Arizona State University, and has devoted his adult life in service to America. The Joneses are a proud military family and wish to honor all Chandler High graduates who have served our country in uniform, past, present and future.
