Chandler High is gearing up for its 100th Year Celebration! Check out all of the terrific events we've got planned:

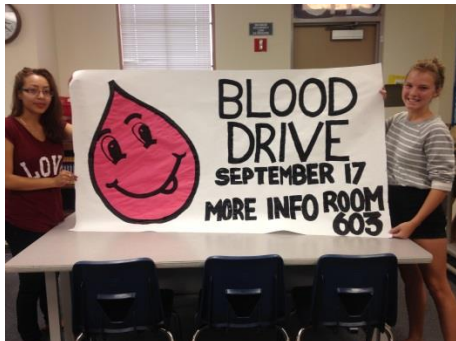
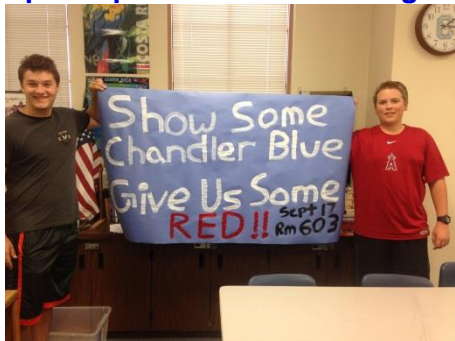
