QUALIFICATIONS

- Minimal risk for Danger to Self or others; Low acuity for psychiatric symptoms
- 18 and older
- Individual should be voluntary to accept service by CTN
- NOT receiving Title 19 SMI case management
- This program is ideal for Non-Title 19 individuals who are not case managed and receiving services or who may be enrolled but are without any connection to behavioral health or substance abuse services.
