### **Course Overview**

### **Course Description**

This course provides an interdisciplinary approach to the topics covered in Integrated Science 7 by focusing on design thinking and problem-based learning. Students will explore science concepts using an inquiry-based approach emphasizing the development and use of models, constructing explanations and designing solutions, collecting and analyzing data, planning and carrying out investigations, communicating information, and supporting arguments based on evidence. Topics include thermodynamics, forces, motion, Newton's Laws, and the cycling of matter and energy through the hydrosphere, atmosphere, and geosphere.
