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### Learning in our Classroom

5<sup>th</sup> Grade Language Arts: This week, we are working in Lesson 25, which features a historical fiction anchor text about Lewis and Clark. We will cover main idea and details as well as primary sources. Our grammar focus will be on contractions. Our vocabulary strategy is on analogies.

Accelerated Language Arts: The students will be reading "Space Trash" from our Harcourt series. This is informational text. We are also working on the literature book title Across Five Aprils. We will also be working on the Civil War menu.

Writing: Students will use their Civil War journal to write responses to Civil War videos and articles.

5<sup>th</sup> Grade Math: The students will continue working on a unit on measurement. We will focus on capacity and measurement on a line plot.

Accelerated Math: We are in our textbook's last chapter on Statistical Displays. Students will be studying data distributions and line graphs. The textbook has online resources for extra support and practice.

Science/Social Studies: We will work on our Civil War unit and will begin a simulation involving elements of the war.
