**Critter Bus K-5 / Main Event 6<sup>th</sup> Grade** – Used funding to pay for Critter Bus / Project Exploration to come on campus and expose students to a variety of animals and learn about their habitats and adaptations. **Tours** – In the last year, tours have been opened up 2x month each month. Some have been scheduled outside schedule as families are moving from out of state. We hosted two Kinder Open House nights. Due to low birth rate and people not selling their homes, enrollment has declined district-wide. District has reimagined schools, such as Galveston.

**School Climate Survey** – kids surveyed in grades 4<sup>th</sup>-6<sup>th</sup>, compared 22-23 to 23-24, saw an increase in "Someone at this school cares for me." Our average score is overall higher than the district's average in all areas.
