- Lori Walter presented Tax Credit policies and procedures and gave an overview of the areas upon which CTA Independence has been or will be spending 2022/23 Tax Credit monies, including grade level field trips, Transportation for field trips, Student Activity clubs (Student Council, Running Club, NEHS) T-shirts, Books for Battle of the Books, Co-Curricular, Character Education, Art Masterpiece, Junior Achievement and Spelling Bee Programs, Million Word Club, AR Renewal, Chromebooks and Google License, FAN Photos, or programs in which payment would represent an economic hardship for a student.
- Lori Walter made a motion to approve the allowable expenditure areas for the 2022-23 school year. Elizabeth Sacco seconded the motion. All present approved.
- The Site Council agreed that the above mentioned items were appropriate for the spending of tax credit monies, retroactive to July 1, 2022. New budget approved.
