Student Responsibilities

The classroom management plan will use the following interventions when behavior falls short of expectations: verbal warning, reflection Form, phone call home, student meeting with behavior specialist, removal from an activity or the classroom, assignment of lunch or after school detention, and parent/administration contact.

Late work

Students are responsible for completing all class work and homework on time. It is the student's responsibility to get homework or make-up work for absences. (CUSD STUDENT RESPONSIBILITIES – Policy JI)

* Homework is always due at beginning of the class (Classwork turned in at the end of).

* Accept late work within FIVE school days after due date, with penalty conditions. Will take 10% off every day it is late, Max penalty capping at 50% off.

* Students who are absent will be required to make up all work missed in his/her classes. It is the student's responsibility to obtain all missed assignments. The following guidelines have been established with regards to make-up work.

For each day missed, the student has at least an equal number of days to complete the make-up work assigned. Failure to do so may result in a failing grade or no credit.

Only in cases involving an extended illness of more than THREE consecutive days, should parents contact the school to make arrangements to pick up the student's work. In this situation, additional make-up assignments may be required upon the student's return. Please Note: Work must be requested 24 hours in advance of pick-up. (Policy IKEA)

Assessments and Assignments

Students will complete assessments during each unit of study to assess their understanding. Students will complete the CUSD Common Final at the end of the first and second semesters. The Common Final will count for 20% of the student's final semester grade in grades 9-12 and 10% in grades 7-8 (some exceptions may apply at the Junior High level). Common finals will be in ELA, Math, Science, Social Science, and World Language.

Final exams will be given during the CUSD Jr High/High School Early Dismissal days in December and May, as identified on the [District Calendar](#).

If students are requested to participate in a survey, the survey questions will be provided to parents/guardians seven days before student contact.
