Course Overview

Course Description

This course develops student understanding of proportional relationships, operations with rational numbers, and work with expressions, inequalities, and linear equations. Students will extend their previous knowledge of fractions, decimals, and integers, solve problems in a real-world context involving measurement, area, surface area, and volume, and investigate statistics and probability. This course provides a more rigorous approach to the topics covered in MAT700 as preparation for AP or IB programs. Students will use the standards for mathematical practice to engage with the subject matter.

Assessments and Assignments

Students will complete assessments during each unit of study to assess their understanding. Students will complete the CUSD Common Final at the end of the first and second semesters. The Common Final will count for 20% of the student's final semester grade in grades 9-12 and 10% in grades 7-8 (some exceptions may apply at the Junior High level). Common finals will be in ELA, Math, Science, Social Science, and World Language.

Final exams will be given during the CUSD Jr High/High School Early Dismissal days in December and May, as identified on the <u>District Calendar</u>.
