### Kindergarten:

- 4 packs of crayons (8 for DLI)
- 12 glue sticks
- 2 black dry erase markers
- 1 labeled pair of headphones
- Backpack large enough to fit 1 inch binder and lunchbox

### 1st Grade:

- 1 pack of crayons (2 for DLI)
- Dry erase markers
- Scissors
- 2 dozen pencils
- Glue sticks (12)

- Water Bottle (bring daily)
- Backpack (prefer NO wheels)
- 1 labeled pair of headphones

### 2nd Grade:

- 1 pair of scissors (labeled)
- 1 pencil pouch or pencil box
- Headphones or earbuds (labeled)
- Disinfecting wipes or baby wipes
- Tissues

### 5th Grade:

- Wired headphones or earbuds
- Conventional - 5 single-subject spiral notebooks, wide-ruled (*Bring to class the first day w/ student's name on the inside of each front cover*)
- DLI - 8 Single-subject spiral notebooks, wide-ruled (2 blue, 2 red, 2 green, 2 yellow)
- One- 1 inch binder
- Crayola Colored Pencils (Preferably Twistables)
- 1 pair of scissors (labeled w/ student's name)
- Pencil Top Erasers
- 4 packages of notebook paper (wide-ruled)
- 2 packs of tab dividers w/8 tabs each (CLEAR tabs- no color)
- 2 dozen pencils
- 3 colored pens (blue, red, and green)
- Yellow highlighters (prefer thin size, non-retractable)
- Expo dry erase markers (BLACK - LOW ODOR)
- Large pencil pouch for 3-ring binder- (NO PENCIL BOXES)

#### DLI:

- Check Registry (available for free at banks)
- 8 Dividers with pockets

- Wide-ruled reinforced 3-hole punched paper

- mini whiteboard eraser (or old small cloth or sock )
- 2 Highlighters (2 different colors) one yellow and one other "light" color of choice
- 6-Sided pencils (Ticonderoga works best in the electric sharpeners)
- Colored pencils
- 6-inch ruler
- 1 Glue stick

- Gift Wrap Tape (scotch tape) for interactive notebooks
- Wired Earbuds
- Standard calculator (square root key needed; inexpensive)
- Pencil pouch for supplies (Please NO pencil boxes)
- Backpack (prefer NO wheels)

### Conventional:

- 8 dividers with pockets
- 2 spiral notebooks, wide-ruled ONLY, your choice or color/design (ELA)
- 3 composition books, wide-ruled ONLY, your choice of color/design (Math/ SS/Sci)
- 1 pen, any color except black
- 1 highlighter, yellow
- Dry erase markers: black only
- 6 sided pencils
- Colored pencils
- Glue stick
- 1" 3 ring binder, your choice of color/design
- Standard calculator (square root key needed, inexpensive)
- Pencil pouch to secure supplies
- Backpack (prefer NO wheels)
- Wired Earbuds

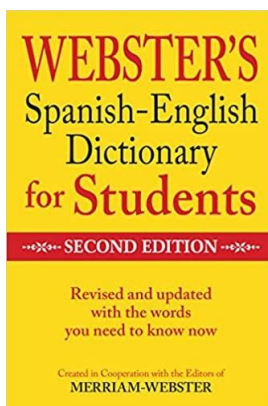


5th and 6th grade DLI Families~
