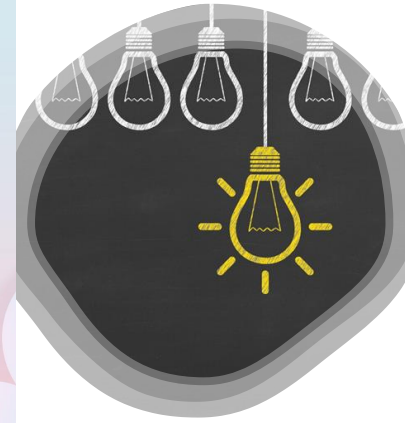

Homework:

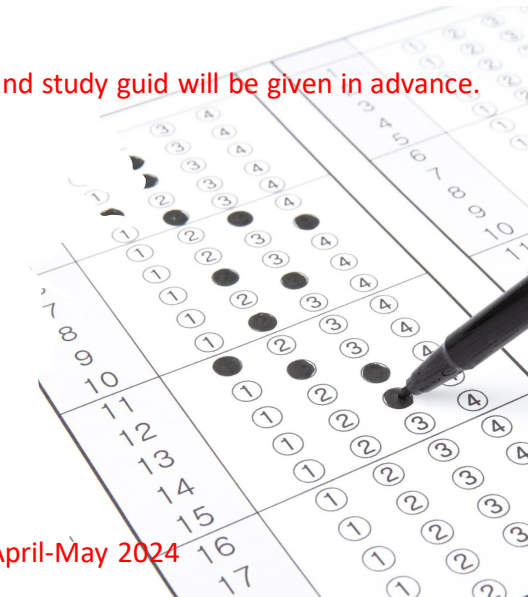
- ✓ Reading Log (Mandarin Matrix-weekly)

Grading Policy



- The grading policy is based on a combination of Classwork, Homework, Speaking Performance, and Written Test.

•Quarter grades

- Homework 20%
- Classwork 20%
- Speaking Performance 30%
- Written Test 30%
- Total 100%

Semester grades

Semester grades are calculated using 45/45/10:
Each quarter accounts for 45% of the semester grade and the final exam accounts for the remaining 10%.

Absent and Late work Policy



- I understand that students may occasionally miss class due to illness or other unforeseen circumstances.
- If your child is absent, please notify me as soon as possible. For each day absent, a student will be given a day to make up their work.

Tutoring Hour

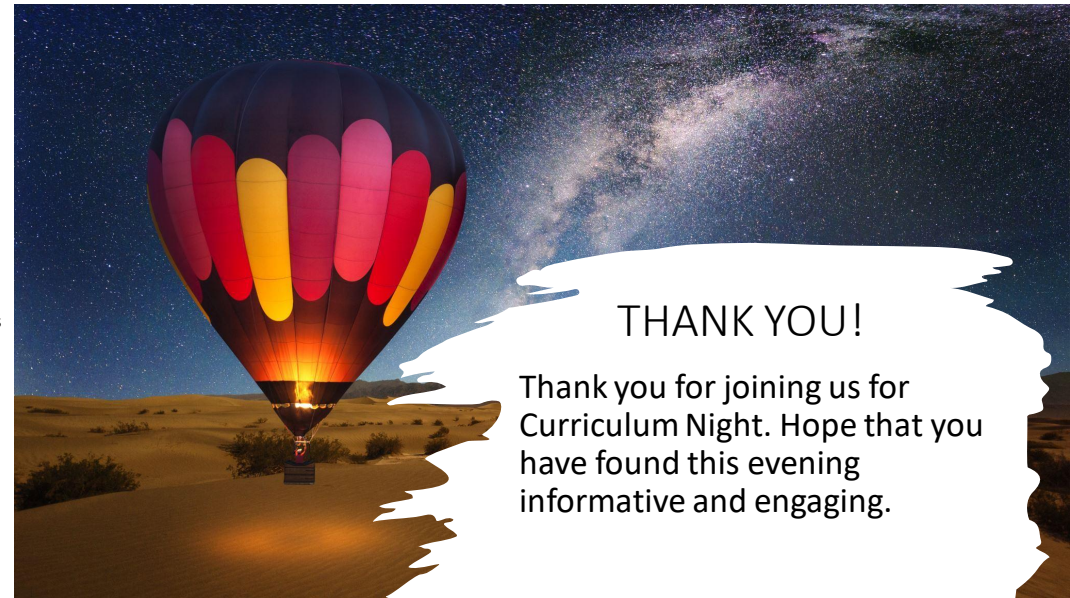
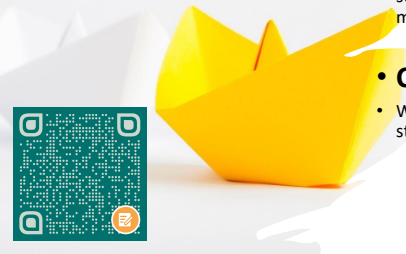
