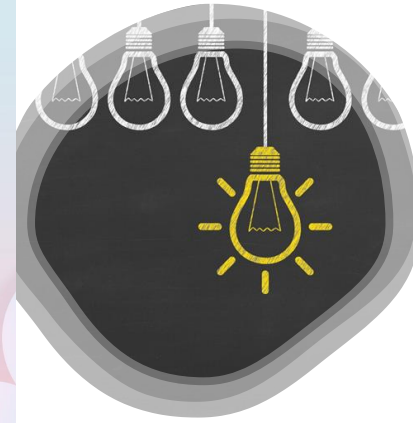



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- Quarter grades and Semester grades are calculated using this course will only report a quarter grade as "pass" or "fail".


Absent and Late work Policy

 - All Materials used in this class will share in Google Classroom.

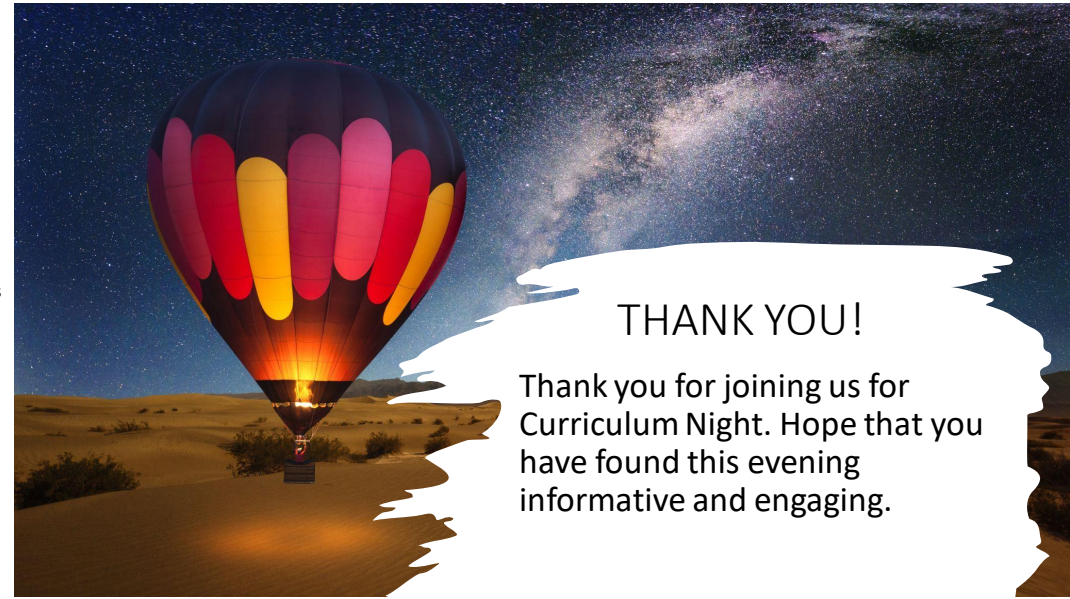
Tutoring Hour
