SUBJECT: USAF JROTC Uniform Wear Policy

1. All USAF Junior ROTC cadets are required to wear the issued USAF JROTC uniform on the prescribed uniform day for each week. This is a mandatory requirement for this class. Cadets must also adhere to the grooming standards outlined in Chapter 3 of the JROTC Handbook (issued the first week of class). **Failure to wear the uniform two times during one semester (three times for freshman) will result in the student receiving a grade of "F" for their class and the student can be dropped from AFJROTC.** Students who do not wear the USAF JROTC uniform on the scheduled uniform wear day must wear the uniform on the next school day that they have their Aerospace Science class. Students who have been excused from an *entire* week of school do not have to make up the previous week's uniform wear. The SASI will render a decision on make up uniform wear on a case-by-case basis.
2. All USAF JROTC service and duty uniforms are issued to each cadet, at no cost, in a clean, dry, and serviceable condition. Each cadet is responsible for maintaining their uniforms. The shirts/blouses, socks, undershirt, Operational Camouflage Pattern (OCP)/Airman Battle Uniform (ABU), Flight Duty Uniform (FDU), and PT uniforms may be machine washed, but the service pants, skirt, coat, tie/tab, flight cap and lightweight blue jacket must be dry cleaned. **NOT AT HOME WITH HOME DRY CLEANING PRODUCTS.**
3. **NEW CADETS:** All new cadets are required to pay a **\$50.00 uniform dry-cleaning fee and can be paid through Infinite Campus.** The fee will be carried over to subsequent school years, so long as you remain in JROTC. When you leave JROTC by graduating, moving, etc., the funds will be used to have your returned items cleaned.
4. If you damage, lose, destroy, or otherwise render uniform items unserviceable due to negligence you will be required to pay for the uniform item so it can be replaced. If an item becomes unserviceable during normal use, the instructors will determine whether the item will be replaced at no charge or simply removed from inventory.
5. The USAF JROTC uniform should be worn proudly. How you wear the uniform will either bring praise or fault by all military personnel, fellow cadets, fellow students, and teachers. When you enrolled in an AFJROTC class you agreed to follow this uniform wear policy. Each student and their parents or guardians will sign below to acknowledge that they understand the USAF JROTC Uniform Policy.
